JEFFERSONVILLE AQUATIC CENTER RULES & REGULATIONS

Jeffersonville Parks and Recreation wants everyone to enjoy the Aquatic Center. That's why we ask that all members and guests follow these guidelines:

- Passes are discounted admissions and program fees, not "memberships". Passes do not guarantee entry or insinuate special privileges.
- Children 15 years or younger must be under the constant supervision by a person 18 years or older.
- **SWIM SUITS ONLY!** No cut-offs or street clothes permitted in water.
- These items are NOT permitted in the Aquatic Center:
 - Glass containers
 - Lawn Furniture of any kind
 - Animals
 - Chewing Gum
 - Tobacco products of any kind or e-cigarettes
- Coolers, food or beverages including alcohol may NOT be brought into the facility.
- Radios, or stereo equipment are not allowed in pool area. Personal size radios with headphones are allowed.
- Admission to the Aquatic Center is refused to all persons having contagious diseases or infections.
- No person shall be allowed to enter the facility while they appear to be under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.
- Street shoes are not permitted on deck.
- The Jeffersonville Aquatic Center reserves the right to prohibit any person from using this facility because of conduct which is detrimental to self and others.
- The use of a floatation device is not permitted unless authorized by pool manager.
- Diving is only permitted off the diving board.
- Not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Profanity will not be tolerated.
- Please, no public displays of affection anywhere inside the Aquatic Center.
- It is unlawful for sex offender to enter the park. Entry upon the premises may constitute the crime of criminal trespass and violators may be subject to arrest and prosecution.
- The Aquatic Center will be open DAILY from Saturday, May 28, thru Sunday, August 7, 2022. Beginning Saturday August 13, 2022, the pool will be open on Saturday and Sunday ONLY with regularly scheduled hours through and including Labor Day, Monday, September 5, 2022. The Parks Department makes no guarantee to be open to the public in situations the management staff determines to be dangerous or during pre-determined special events.
